

## **ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIPS**

The Erasmus+ Traineeship programme allows students to pass between 2 and 12 months abroad (in EU states) to perform research related activities in overseas universities, research centres or companies. It is typically used for part of the Master's thesis work, or by PhD students, although it is possible to undertake traineeships after graduation as long as the candidate completes the application before graduating.

Traineeships must be completed within the academic year (September to September) in which they are awarded, and are based on individual agreements between the host institution and the University of Milan. Such agreements can be organized by UNIMI tutors, or by candidates themselves (with the involvement of a UNIMI tutor).

There are usually 2 calls for traineeship proposals each year (in late summer and around Christmas) and candidates are typically interviewed by a dedicated commission to evaluate the proposed activity and the appropriate linguistic capacity of the candidate.

Individuals interested in incoming opportunities through the Erasmus+ Traineeship programme can, in conjunction with their home university tutor, directly contact UNIMI professors in the appropriate scientific sector to discuss potential collaborations.
